The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted. The judgment is vacated, and the case is remanded to the Supreme Court of North Carolina for further consideration in light of *Cooper v. Harris*, 581 U. S. ____ (2017).

Because the Court lacks a quorum, 28 U. S.
