17-1201 THACKER, GARY, ET UX. V. TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY

The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted.

17-1471 HOME DEPOT U.S.A., INC. V. JACKSON, GEORGE W.

The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted. In addition to the questions presented by the petition, the parties are directed to brief and argue the following question: Should this Court's holding in *Shamrock Oil & Gas Corp. v. Sheets*, 313 U. S. 100 (1941)—that an original plaintiff may not remove a counterclaim against it—extend to third-party counterclaim defendants?

17-1484 AZAR, SEC. OF H&HS V. ALLINA HEALTH SERVICES, ET AL.

The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted limited to the following question: Whether 42 U. S. C. §1395hh(a)(2) or §1395hh(a)(4) required the Department of Health and Human Services to conduct notice-and-comment rulemaking before providing the challenged instructions to a Medicare Administrator Contractor making initial determinations of payments due under Medicare.
